Size: Tree < 30 feet, Shrub > 8 feet Height: 10' - 15' (spread 10' - 15')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: neat, rounded shape (easily maintained)

Ornamental Other: sun or partial shade

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Cultivar Name	Notes
Brevipetala	'Brevipetala' - abundant, fragrant, showy, large yellow blooms with a reddish base; retains dead leaves, a trait seen as unattractive by some
Coombe Wood	'Coombe Wood' - larger in all parts; gold-yellow blooms with a purple-red base; large, broad habit; large leaves
Palida	Pleasantly fragrant abundant light yellow blooms; broad-spreading habit; blooms appear early in the season, often by February
