#### Cultivar Information

#### Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Groundcover, Vine

Height: 12

Leaves: Evergreen

Shape: Clinging vine or ground cover

Ornamental Other: growth is maximized in rich, organic soil; some protection from full winter sun and wind is necessary at the northern edges of zone 5b to avoid winter drying of foliage

#### Environmental Characteristics

Light: Part shade, Shade

Hardy To Zone: 5b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: evergreen; dark green lustrous foliage clings to anything; black fruits throughout the winter

Cultivar Name	Notes
Thorndale	'Thorndale' -hardy and salt tolerant; large, glossy leaves with white veins
Arborescens	'Arborescens' - shrubby form, non-vining; ovate, unlobed leaves as an adult
Baltica	'Baltica' - hardy form; smaller leaves than species
Bulgaria	'Bulgaria' - one of the hardiest forms; drought resistant
Hibernica	'Hibernica' - larger, more shiny leaves
Ogalalla	'Ogalalla' - very hard
Purpurea	'Purpurea' - purplish foliage turns darker or bronze in winter
Rochester	'Rochester' - hardy form; small to medium leaves
Treetop	'Treetop' - hardy adult form; produces flowers and fruit; probably best avoided in areas where this species is invasive
Wilsonii	'Wilsonii' (a.k.a. 'Wilson') - hardy form; small, pointed leaves; compact habit
Buttercup	'Buttercup' - foliage pale green in shade, gold to chartreuse in sun
