Cultivar Name	Notes
Blue Rabbit	'Blue Rabbit' - narrow, pyramidal
Diana	'Diana' - contorted branches
Pendula	'Pendula' - weeping form
Wolterdingen	'Wolterdingen' -dwarf; compact, spreading form; soft, new, blue-green needles
Blue Dwarf	'Blue Dwarf' - dwarf ; soft blue leaves; grown as a small standard tree, forms a domed crown; grows to 2' high in 10 years
