Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Tree > 30 feet

Height: 30' - 40' (equal spread)

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: oval to rounded

Ornamental Other: prefers deep soil rich in organic matter; sun to part shade; shelter from drying winds

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 5b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)
