Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Groundcover

Height: 6"

Leaves: Evergreen

Shape: slow to establish spreading ground cover

Ornamental Other: part shade to full shade; prefers organic soil, sheltered location. Slow growing

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Part shade, Shade

Hardy To Zone: 5a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: deciduous to semi-evergreen; beautiful green to blue-green foliage; white or

pink flowers in March/April (more showy than P. terminalis); excellent in woodland setting
