Size: Tree > 30 feet

Height: 50' - 75' (40' - 70'+)

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: upright oval to rounded Ornamental Other: Slow growing

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun

Hardy To Zone: 4a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: full sun or light shade; avoid extremely dry situations
