#### Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub > 8 feet

Height: 12' - 18' (spread 8' - 12')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: upright dense hedge

Ornamental Other: tolerant of poor soil fertility

#### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: red fruits quickly turn purple or black

Cultivar Name	Notes
Asplenifolia	'Asplenifolia' - leaves are linear with a wavy margin, fine-textured, cut-leaf form
Columnaris	'Columnaris' - narrow upright form
Fine Line	'Fine Line' (a.k.a. 'Ron Williams') - columnar habit; fine textured foliage, leaves are linear with a wavy margin, fine-textured
