Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Tree < 30 feet, Shrub > 8 feet Height: 6' - 20' (spread 10' - 20')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: erect stems; suckering from base

Ornamental Other: native to coastal North America, north of Florida, found in bogs and swampy

areas

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 3b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4)

Environmental Other: white flowers in early spring; edible globular berries; yellow fall color

Insect Disease

possible problem with fireblight

Bare Root Transplanting

Moderately difficult

Cultivar Name	Notes
Prince William	'Prince William' - possibly a hybrid with A. laevis; multi-stemmed, shrubby form; not exceeding 10'; spring foliage emerges red; good fruit set; multi-colored fall leaves
Rainbow Pillar	'Rainbow Pillar' (a.k.a. 'Glenform') - shrubby form; upright, narrow habit; to 20' tall
Spring Glory	'Spring Glory' (a.k.a. 'Sprizam') - compact, upright habit; to 12' tall and 8'-10' wide; orange/yellow fall color
Tradition	'Tradition' (a.k.a.'Trazam') - maintains a central leader; to 25 '- 30 ' tall; good early bloom
