#### **C**rnamental Characteristics

Size: Tree > 30 feet
Height: 30' - 60' (spread 25' - 40')
Leaves: Deciduous
Shape: pyramidal; irregular
Ornamental Other: various soils; full sun or light shade

#### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Full sun, Part shade Hardy To Zone: 5b Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4) Environmental Other: bright green foliage turns brilliant yellow, orange, red in fall; dark cinnamon furrowed bark; blue-black fruits and bright red stalks

#### Insect Disease

relatively free of problems; borers and bagworms may seriously weaken trees
