Ornamental Other: prefers full sun and open areas; more sensitive to calcareous soils than most spireas

Cultivar Name	Notes
Anthony Waterer	'Anthony Waterer' - blooms intermittently for several weeks
Gold Flame	many cvs: 'Anthony Waterer' (blooms intermittently for several weeks)[]'Gold Flame' (leaves 'on fire' when they emerge in spring)[]'Goldmound' (chartreuse yellow foliage)[]'Little Princess' (deeper pink flower)
Goldmound	'Goldmound' - chartreuse yellow foliage
Little Princess	'Little Princess' - deeper pink flower
Coccinea	'Coccinea' - compact-rounded form; deep reddish flowers; grows to 3' tall and wider
Crispa	'Crispa' - finely-textured leaves that are twisted and dissected; shows occasional foliar variegation
Dolchica	'Dolchica' - finely-textured leaves that are twisted and dissected; does not produce random variegated foliage; grows to 3' tall and wide
Froebelii	'Froebelii' - lacks irregular variegated shoots; good heat/drought tolerance; bright pink flowers
Gumball	'Gumball' (a.k.a. 'Dwarf Froebel') - similar to Froebelii, grows to 3' tall and wider
Limemound	'Limemound' - leaves emerge yellow-orange and age to lime green; exhibits better cold hardiness; in other respects this variety is similar to 'Goldflame'
