Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet Height: 6' - 8' (spread 10' - 12') Leaves: Deciduous Shape: arching, fountain-like Ornamental Other: prefers full sun

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade Hardy To Zone: 3b Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0) Environmental Other: profusion of showy white flowers in late May; distinctive blue-green foliage

Cultivar Name	Notes
Pink Ice	'Pink Ice' - young foliage splashed with pink and white; plant can reach 5' tall in time
Renaissance	'Renaissance' - very similar to species, exhibits greater resistance to leaf ailments
Snow White	'Snow White' - compact form; less prone to foliar diseases; dead blooms are self- cleaning; foliage is larger than species; grows to 5' tall and wide
Firegold	'Firegold' (a.k.a. 'Levgold') - lemon-lime foliage starts soft yellow, then lemon, then ages to lime-green; grows to $4 - 6'$ tall x $5 - 7'$ wide
Gold Fountain	'Gold Fountain' – yellow, scalloped leaves which turn soft orange to red in autumn; white flowers touched with pink
