### **Cultivar Information**

Many cultivars exist for this species. All are currently susceptible to the Viburnum Leaf Beetle. Below are some of the cultivars this species has on offer.

### Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub > 8 feet, Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 8' - 10' (spread 8' - 10')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: rounded, upright

Ornamental Other: full sun or part shade

### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Salt Tolerance: Tolerates salt spray

## Cultivars for Viburnum dentatum

<b>Cultivar Name</b>	Notes
Chicago Luster	'Chicago Luster' (a.k.a.'Synnestvedt') - upright rounded form; glossy, deep green foliage; reddish purple fall color; blooms slightly later than the species; grows to 8 - 10' tall and wide
Blue Muffin	'Blue Muffin' (a.k.a. 'Christom') - compact form; profuse, intense blue fruits; heavy bloomer
Red Feather	'Red Feather' - new foliage emerges red, as it ages, green veins appear on the red surfaces, finally aging to solid green; consistent, long lasting, maroon fall color
Emerald Lustre	'Emerald Lustre' - possibly a V. bracteatum cultivar; glossy dark green foliage; improved performance in warmer zones from 6 south; abundant purple-black fruit; yellow-bronze fall foliage; best reserved for use in warmer coastal areas
Moonglow	'Moonglow' - larger glossy dark green leaves; fruits appear slightly later than other selections and are a bit larger
Morton	'Morton' (a.k.a. Northern Burgundy) - blooms in late June; prolific blue-black fruit; burgundy fall color plant grows larger than other selections, to 12' tall and wide
Autumn Jazz	'Autumn Jazz' (a.k.a.'Ralph Senior') - upright, vase-like form; fall color that is a mix of yellow, red and purple; grows from $10$ - $12$ ' tall x $8$ - $10$ ' wide
Pathfinder	'Pathfinder' (a.k.a. 'Patzam') - upright form; glossy dark green and serrated foliage; grows to $6'$ tall x $4'$ wide
Perle Bleu	'Perle Bleu' - ample round, blue fruit; grows to 10'-12' tall
Blue Blaze	'Blue Blaze'- compact, thick, dense form; incredibly dark green, lustrous foliage; deep blue-black berries; purplish-red fall foliage; grows to 5-6' tall and wide
