#### **C**rnamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub > 8 feet
Height: 8' - 12' (spread 8' - 12')
Leaves: Deciduous
Shape: loose and open shrub with arching habit when mature

Light: Full sun Hardy To Zone: 5a Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

# Cultivars for Viburnum farreri

### Showing **1-7** of **7** items.

Cultivar Name	Notes
Compactum	'Compactum' - dwarf form
Nanum	'Nanum' - dwarf, dense, mounded habit!; pink buds open to white, sweet scented flowers; may have somewhat sparse flowering in its early years; small, semi-glossy, bronze-green leaves; grows to only 2-4' tall and as wide
Dawn	'Dawn' - a V. x bodnantense cultivar; brighter pink flowers than species
Album	'Album' - white flowered form; otherwise similar to species
Candidissimum	'Candidissimum' - very fragrant white flowered form; flowers earliest of all V. farreri cultivars; grows 8 - 10' tall
December Dwarf	'December Dwarf' - dwarf upright form; grows to 3' tall and slightly less wide
Farrer's Pink	'Farrer's Pink' - large upright form; deep pink buds open to sweet scented pinker flowers than species; very tolerant of pruning; showy rich mahogany bark
