#### **Crnamental Characteristics**

Size:

Height: 12' - 15' (spread 12' - 15')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: upright rounded

Ornamental Other: not heat tolerant and best suited to colder climates

#### **Environmental Characteristics**

Environmental Other: white flowers appear in flat clusters in late May; berry-like fruits are effective

in August - October; dark green leathery leaves turn yellow to red in fall
