### **Crnamental Characteristics**

Size: Groundcover

Height: 3

Leaves: Evergreen
Shape: groundcover

Ornamental Other: prefers soil abundantly supplied with organic matter; can tolerate poor soils but

will not develop and fill in as fast; shade tolerant

#### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Part shade, Shade

Hardy To Zone: 4b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: lilac blue flowers in March; shiny green foliage

| Cultivar Name     | Notes                                                                                                                                                                                     |
|-------------------|-------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Alba              | 'Alba' - white flowers and smaller foliage                                                                                                                                                |
| Alba Plena        | 'Alba Plena' (a.k.a 'Albo Plena') - double white flowers; otherwise similar to species                                                                                                    |
| Atropurpurea      | 'Atropurpurea' - deep plum-purple blooms; flowers are larger than species; otherwise similar to species                                                                                   |
| Florepleno        | 'Florepleno' (a.k.a. 'Flore Pleno', 'Multiplex') - double-flowered form with purpleblue petals                                                                                            |
| Gertrude Jekyll   | 'Gertrude Jekyll' (a.k.a. 'Miss Jekyll') - dwarf, compact form; pure white flowers; plants smaller in all parts                                                                           |
| Illumination      | 'Illumination' - golden yellow variegation in the center of each leaf, the margin of green is so thin that the entire plant appears yellow; vigorous grower; purple blooms                |
| La Grave          | 'La Grave' (a.k.a. 'Bowlesii', 'Bowles Variety') - profuse, larger lavender-blue flowers; stronger clumping habit than species, thus more plants may be needed to complete mass plantings |
| Ralph Shugert     | 'Ralph Shugert' - similar to 'La Grave', regular border of creamy white around each leaf                                                                                                  |
| Sterling Silver   | 'Sterling Silver' - cream variegated leaves; pale violet blooms                                                                                                                           |
| Argenteovariegata | 'Argenteovariegata' - variegated with white edges                                                                                                                                         |
| Aureovariegata    | 'Aureovariegata' (a.k.a. 'Aureomarginata') - golden variegation along leaf edges                                                                                                          |
