Alba	'Alba' - white flowering form
Issai	'Issai' - bluish flowers
Issai Perfect	'Issai Perfect' - white flower clusters, grow to 14" long
Longissima Alba	'Longissima Alba' - fragrant white flower clusters; grow to 14" long
Macrobotrys	'Macrobotrys' - lavender blue flower clusters 18" - 36" long
Rosea	'Rosea' - fragrant pink flower clusters 18" long
Royal Purple	'Royal Purple' - deep violet flower clusters 12" long
