Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Tree > 30 feet
Height: to 100'
Leaves: Evergreen
Shape: conical; spire-like
Ornamental Other: Beautiful long branches that sweep down to the ground. Rare in the nursery trade.

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade Hardy To Zone: 3a Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4) Environmental Other: Tolerates more shade than other firs.

| Cultivar Name | Notes |
|------------------|--|
| Barabit's Star | needles curve downward on stems with silver bark. The needles fan out as they extend along the new growth in an unusual arrangement that resembles plump, fluffy brushes |
| Green Spiral | semi-pendulous |
| Holden Arboretum | horizontal habit; compact branches spreading out in low, dense layers; |
| Pancake | flat-topped dwarf to 2'x2' in 10 years; tiers of dark-green, glossy foliage look like pancakes stacked atop each other |
| Pendula | upright main leader with pendulous side branches |
| Pyramidalis | dense, semi-columnar growth with up-swept branches |
