Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet
Height: 4' - 8'
Leaves: Evergreen
Shape: mounded, dense
Ornamental Other: desiccating wind can brown leaves and cause them to drop; best grown in shade.

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Part shade, Shade Hardy To Zone: 5a Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0) Environmental Other: evergreen; thorns; lustrous green;

Environmental Other: evergreen; thorns; lustrous green foliage; abundant yellow flowers in March; bluish-black fruits in fall; good barrier or hedge
