#### **C**rnamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 4' - 8' (spread 6' - 12')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: small, round, mounded shrub with clean branch structure in summer and winter

Ornamental Other: prefers alkaline soil

**Environmental Characteristics** 

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: spectacular violet flowers emerge before leaves are fully developed and cover the plant in May; new leaves have purplish margins turning to dark green lustrous foliage; medium fine texture

#### Insect Disease

not as susceptible to mildew as other lilacs; several diseases may cause problems but none serious; one of the most maintenance-free lilacs
