Cultivar Name	Notes
Emerald Mound	'Emerald Mound' - mounding habit; grows to 3' tall x 6' wide; blue-green foliage; creamy yellow flowers; red fruit; resistant to Honeysuckle Aphid; leafs out very early in spring
Claveyi	'Claveyi' - grows quickly; resists salt damage; grows to 6' tall with an equal spread; yellow flowers; red fruit
Miniglobe	'Miniglobe' - compact form, growing to 4' tall and wide; excellent hardiness; tight growth; flowers and fruit are not conspicuous
