Edward Goucher	lavender-pink flowers with orangish yellow throats
Francis Mason	copper colored new leaves
Golden Anniversary	a.k.a. Minipan, compact sport of A. Compacta bright green leaves variegated with creamy yellow to golden yellow margins
Golden Glow	golden foliage
John Creech	dense and upright
Kaleidoscope	compact dwarf to 2', red, orange, and yellow variegated leaves
Little Richard	prolific flowers, compact
Prostrata	low and broad-spreading
Really Pink	evergreen to -10 to -15 degrees F
Sherwoodii	dense and compact
Silver Anniversary	a.k.a 'Panache, compact sport of A. Prostrata attractive red-tinted, bright green leaves variegated with silver to cream margins.
Sunrise	green leaves with golden margin
Funshine	Bright yellow and orange foliage, 2-3' tall
Sunny Anniversary	Large fragrant flowers, yellow blooms with pink and orange throats, 3-4.
