Cultivar Name	Notes
Moonlight	'Moonlight' - silvery blue leaves with contrasting green veining
Rose Sensation	'Rose Sensation' (a.k.a. Rosea, Roseum) - pale pink bracts
Platt Dwarf	'Platt Dwarf' - smaller leaves and flowers than species; grows to 20- 25' tall
Brookside Miniature	'Brookside Miniature' - grows to 20' tall
