Cultivar Name	Notes
Beijing Gold	'Beijing Gold' (a.k.a. 'Zhang Zhiming') - primrose-yellow flowers; cinnamon-colored bark; yellow-gold fall color; grows to 20 ' tall x 15 ' wide
China Snow	'China Snow' (a.k.a. Morton) - upright-rounded habit; fragrant white flowers; cinnamon-colored exfoliating bark; grows to 40' tall x 35' wide
Copper Curls	'Copper Curls' (a.k.a. 'SunDak') - superior bark color and exfoliation; grows to 20 - 25' tall
Great Wall	'Great Wall' - branches sweep upward to give the tree a formal outline; bright white flowers; lustrous green foliage; cinnamon colored exfoliating bark; grows to $20'$ tall x $12'$ wide
Pendula	'Pendula' - pendulous habit; creamy white blooms; grows to 10-12' tall x 8' wide in 10 years
