#### **C**rnamental Characteristics

Size: Tree < 30 feet, Shrub > 8 feet

Height: 15' (spread 15' - 20')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: upright, multi-stemmed

Ornamental Other: tolerant of alkaline soils and extreme cold; fixes its own nitrogen; a very tough plant

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun Hardy To Zone: 3a Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0) Salt Tolerance: Tolerates salt spray, Tolerates salty soil Environmental Other: makes a good windbreak; suitable for container planting; yellow flowers not very showy

## Cultivars for Caragana arborescens

Cultivar Name	Notes
Lobergii	'Lobergii' - graceful form with linear leaves and fine texture; grows to about 8' tall
Nana	'Nana' - dwarf form; contorted branches; height between 3' to 6'; denser foliage than species; more profuse flowers than species
Pendula	'Pendula' - weeping form
Sutherland	'Sutherland' - upright, columnar habit; 16'high by 7' wide
Walker	'Walker' - fernlike foliage; weeping habit; 5' by 5'
