



Species: *Salix eleagnos*

Rosemary Willow

Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub > 8 feet, Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 4-15'

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: Long upright branches with grey/green leaves from base to tip.

Ornamental Other: Distinctive fine textural effect of rosemary like willow leaves. Benefits from cutting back every year or two to encourage dense growth and control height

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)
