### **Crnamental Characteristics**

Size: Tree > 30 feet

Height: 50' - 60; (spread 20' - 30')

Leaves: Evergreen

Shape: pyramidal or conical

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 6a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4)

Environmental Other: full sun / light shade; needs protection from wind

# Cultivars for Cryptomeria japonica

Cultivar Name	Notes
Lobbii	'Lobbii' (denser, less pendulous branching)
Yoshino	'Yoshino' (fast growth; foliage turns bronze green in cold weather);and more
Black Dragon	'Black Dragon' - green spring growth matures to deep black-green in summer; dense, irregular pyramidal form
Radicans	'Radicans' - columnar growth habit; resistant to leaf spot; foliage does not bronze as readily in the fall; suceptible to Phytopthera root rot at a young age
Globosa Nana	'Globosa Nana' - dwarf, globose habit; $4$ - $6$ ' wide x $5$ - $6$ ' tall; minimal bronzing in winter
