Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 3' - 5' (equal spread)

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: upright, leggy shrub

Ornamental Other: shade or sun

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4)

Environmental Other: very fragrant, vivid, rose-purple flowers; large dark blue-green leaves; bright red fruit; semi-evergreen; leaves hold late into December
