Cultivar Name	Notes
Codsall Pink	'Codsall Pink' (a.k.a. 'Godsall' or 'Godsall Pink') - double, pink flowers
Plena	'Plena' (a.k.a. 'Flore Pleno', Flora Plena) - double, pink-tinged, white flowers
Candidissima	'Candidissima' - double, white flowers
Pride of Rochester	'Pride of Rochester' - light pink flowers
Pink Minor	'Pink Minor' - dwarf growth habit, to 3' tall; pink flowers
Rosea	'Rosea' - single, clear rose-colored flowers
Variegata	'Variegata' - variegated foliage; rversions and fading to solid green foliage may occur
Punctata	'Punctata' - variegated foliage; rversions and fading to solid green foliage may occur
