### Autumn Olive

#### **Cultivar Information**

An nvasive species with many improved fruiting varieties, no sterile varieties known.

#### **Crnamental Characteristics**

Size: Shrub > 8 feet

Height: 12' - 18' (spread 12' 18')

Leaves: Deciduous Shape: Upright oval

Ornamental Other: tolerant of climate conditions; fixes its own nitrogen

#### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 5a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: attractive medium green/silver foliage; small fragrant yellow flowers in late

spring; silver fruits turn red in fall and attract many birds
