### Spindle Tree

#### Cultivar Information

Not commonly grown in the U.S. in great numbers; potentially invasive; many cultivars

#### Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Tree < 30 feet

Height: 12' - 30' (10' - 25')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: narrow, upright shrub or small tree

Ornamental Other: full sun - part shade; very tough and tolerant

#### Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: characteristic, attractive, pink-red fruit with orange seeds; medium to dark green leaves turn dull red in fall

susceptible to scale and aphids
