Cultivar Name	Notes
Broadmoor	'Broadmoor' - low-spreading; green foliage
var. tamariscifolia	var. tamariscifolia - broad/mounded; green foliage
Arcadia	'Arcadia' - hardy to USDA zone 3; green foliage; layered, spreading habit; 18" tall x 5' wide; resistant to Juniper blight
Blue Forest	'Blue Forest' - upturned, ascending branches that resemble a miniature "forest"; blue foliage; grows to 18" tall x 3' wide; resistant to Juniper blight, but may suffer from other fungal ailments
Buffalo	'Buffalo' - bright green, feathery foliage; wide-spreading habit; 1' tall x 8' wide; hardy to USDA zone 3
Calgary Carpet	'Calgary Carpet' (a.k.a. 'Monna') - low, spreading form; green foliage with a soft texture; grows to 9 " tall x 6 ' wide
Pepin	'Pepin' - upright form; 3' tall x of 5' wide; blue-green foliage
New Blue	'New Blue' - var. tamariscifolia sport; superior blue foliage
