Height: 1' - (spread is variable)

Leaves: Evergreen

Shape: spreading groundcover

Cultivar Name	Notes
Fuzzball	'Fuzzball' (a.k.a. 'Condavis') - upright, vase-like form; otherwise similar to species
Celtic Pride	'Celtic Pride' - grows to 12 - 15" x 8 - 10'; extremely disease resistant
Drew's Blue	'Drew's Blue' - bluish-green summer foliage turns to maroon color in the winter
Jacobsen	'Jacobsen' - dwarf with a dense compact form; gray-green foliage turns bronzes in winter; grows to 2' x 2' in 10 years
Gold Spot	'Gold Spot' - gold-splotched variegation on foliage


