Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet
Height: 6' - 8' (spread equal or greater)
Leaves: Deciduous
Shape: rounded
Ornamental Other: capable of fixing and using atmospheric nitrogen; can handle poor soil conditions

Environmental Other: aromatic, semi-evergreen leaves; waxy silver berries persist through winter; dioecious; females produce gray/blue berries; fruits and leaves are eaten by many winter birds
