Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Vine

Height: 15' - 20'

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: twining vine

Ornamental Other: green, pink and white foliage is more showy when grown in calcareous soils

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 3a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: purplish/ white/ pink foliage; fragrant white flowers in May/June; yellow fruit is sweet and edible, ripening in Sept/Oct

Cultivar Name	Notes
Arctic Beauty	'Arctic Beauty' - male; cold hardy with smaller leaves that open purple and mature to pink, white, green
Krupnoplalnaya	'Krupnoplalnaya' - large red tinted leaves, vigorous
Red Beauty	'Red Beauty' fruiting female similar to 'Arctic Beauty'
