#### **Crnamental Characteristics**

Size: Groundcover

Height: 6

Leaves: Evergreen

Shape: spreading groundcover

Ornamental Other: requires shade for satisfactory performance; prefers soils abundantly supplied

with organic matter

### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Part shade, Shade

Hardy To Zone: 5a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: new foliage is light green turning deep dark green; commonly used
