Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Vine

Height: 30' - 50'

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: clinging vine

Ornamental Other: full sun to heavy shade; very tolerant

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade, Shade

Hardy To Zone: 4b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: lustrous green foliage turns brilliant orange-red in fall; fruits add winter interest

Cultivar Name	Notes
Beverly Brooks	'Beverly Brooks' - large leaves, brilliant red fall color
Fenway Park	'Fenway Park' - new foliage is brilliant yellow
Green Showers	'Green Showers' (a.k.a 'Green Spring') - lime green foliage which emerges yellow in spring; large glossy leaves
Lowii	'Lowii' - very small leaves
Purpurea	'Purpurea' - red-purple fall color
Robusta	'Robusta' - vigorous
Veitchii	'Veitchii' - no flowers or fruits, small leaves
