Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Tree > 30 feet

Height: 40' - 50'

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: broad oval

Ornamental Other: Dark green leaves emerge early, turn golden brown in autumn and may persist into winter; deeply ridged and furrowed bark

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun

Hardy To Zone: 5b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4)

Salt Tolerance: Tolerates salty soil

Environmental Other: Does well in occasionally very wet soils

reasonably pest free; preferred by orange-striped oakworm

Cultivar Name	Notes
var. chenii	var. chenii - smooth leaves and smaller acorns
Gobbler	'Gobbler' - abundant production of acorns that are favored by wildlife; profuse production of nuts early in the season
