### **C**rnamental Characteristics

Size: Tree > 30 feet Height: 50' - 80' (equal spread) Leaves: Deciduous Shape: pyramidal to oval/rounded; majestic Ornamental Other: full sun

#### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Full sun Hardy To Zone: 3b Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4)

Environmental Other: dark blue-green to green leaves turn red in fall; bark is light ash brown; mature bark has small scaly plates

#### Insect Disease

anthracnose, bacterial leaf scorch, canker and more: despite many diseases this is a long-lived, durable tree
