Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet, Groundcover

Height: 2' - 6' (spread 6' - 10')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: groundcover; irregular spreading shrub

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Konza	'Konza' - dwarf form, to 2' tall.
Green Globe	'Green Globe' - dense, rounded form; grows to 6'
