Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 3' - 4' (to 10') (spread 10' - 15')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: shrub with fountain of slender branches

Ornamental Other: tolerates dry, heavy soils

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun

Hardy To Zone: 5b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: lustrous bright green foliage turns unattractive yellow in fall; fragrant white single flowers in June; colorful red fruit in August through mid-winter; thorns

Insect Disease

Very susceptible to rose rosette disease. HIGHLY INVASIVE
