Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Tree < 30 feet

Height: 20 - 30' (spread 15' - 20')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: pyramidal-round

Ornamental Other: full sun

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: attractive flowers and persistent red-orange fruit; orange-red fall color; beechlike foliage emerges bright green, turns to dark green and then yellow, golden, orange in fall
