Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 6'

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: upright shrub

Ornamental Other: best in open, sunny areas with good air circulation

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun

Hardy To Zone: 5a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: bright, rose-colored flowers in June/Aug; light to medium green foliage is whitish grey underneath
