#### Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Groundcover

Height: 2' - 3' (spread 4' - 7')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: graceful, arching branches

Ornamental Other: tolerant of considerable shade but looks best when exposed to some direct sun

#### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 5a

Soil Ph: Requires acid (pH 5.0 to 7.0)

Environmental Other: finely cut leaves and slender stems; reddish purple fall color; yellowish/white

flowers in May/June
