

Species: Syringa villosa

(si-ring'gah vil-oh'sah)

Late Lilac

Cultivar Information

Syringa villosa has been crossed with S. reflexa to produce the S. x prestoniae hybrids (the "Preston Lilac Hybrids"). These plants are extremely hardy, to USDA zone 3, and are becoming common in commerce. They resemble their S. villosa parent in most visible respects.

Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub > 8 feet

Height: 6' - 10' (spread 4' - 10')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: bushy, dense, rounded shrub

Ornamental Other: full sun for best flowering

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun

Hardy To Zone: 3a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: rosy lilac to white flowers in May /June; fragrance not sweet like S. vulgaris

Cultivar Name	Notes
Agnes Smith	'Agnes Smith' - upright habit; white fragrant flowers; late blooming; grows to $8^{\rm t}$ tall and wide
Donald Wyman	'Donald Wyman' - dense upright habit; late blooming; profuse panicles of purple buds that open to reveal red-purple blooms; grows to 10' tall with a narrow spread
James MacFarlane	'James MacFarlane' - upright habit; profuse, single, clear pink blooms; grows to 8' tall
Minuet	'Minuet' - slower, more restrained dense growth habit; grows to 8' tall and 6' wide; does not sucker as much as other lilacs; light white-pink blooms; handsome dark green
Miss Canada	'Miss Canada' - upright rounded form; bright pink fragrant flowers; Experts consider this hardy hybrid to be among the best pink lilacs; grows to 10' tall and wide
Aurea	'Aurea' - golden foliage; abundant, fragrant soft pink flowers; grows to 10' tall X 8^{\prime} wide
Redwine	'Redwine' - red purple flowers
