Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub > 8 feet

Height: 8' - 15' (equal spread)

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: large broad-spreading, graceful shrub Ornamental Other: full sun for best flowers

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun

Hardy To Zone: Any

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: fragrant purple lilac flowers in May; dark green leaves
