Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 3' - 6' (spread 3' - 6')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: rounded dense shrub

Cultivar Name	Notes
Cayuga	'Cayuga' - larger flowers; flowers in late April; leaves less susceptible to bacterial leaf spot and powdery mildew
Diana	'Diana' - red flower buds open to white flowers; new growth has purple tint
Compactum	'Compactum' - compact, slow-growing, rounded form; tolerant of juglone; pink buds open in spring to sweetly fragrant white flowers arranged in snowball-like clusters, to 3" across; fall foliage dull red to wine-red to burgundy; grows 2.5 -4' tall and wide
Aurora	'Aurora' - spreading form; dark pink buds open to pastel pink fragrant flowers; red fall color; grows to 6' tall and wide
Marlou	'Marlou' - rounded form; large clusters of sweetly scented white/pale pink flowers; strong growing plant; dark green summer turn shades of purple and bronze before falling in autumn; grow to 6' tall and wide
Sugar n' Spice	'Sugar n' Spice' - dense, rounded form; exceptionally heavy flower production; pink buds open to white flowers; healthy dark green leaves turn an attractive wine-red color in fall
Spice Island	'Spice Island' uniformly compact form; branches better than other <i>Viburnum carlesii</i> 'Compacta' cultivars making for considerably fewer one-sided or poorly structured plants; matures at one half to two thirds the size of species; grows to 5' tall x 6' wide
