Cultivar Name	Notes
Catskill	'Catskill' - dwarf, compact form uniform habit, wider than tall; smaller rounded leaves; yellow, orange and red fall color; long-lasting deep red fruit; grows to 6' tall x 8' wide
Erie	'Erie' - rounded form; fruits ripen red in summer and progress to coral-pink by winter; In autumn, leaves turn shades of red, orange and yellow in fall; grows 6 - 8' tall
Iroquois	'Iroquois' - large, thick, textured, dark green leaves; foliage turns orange to deep red in fall; large, deep red, profuse fruits; vigorous growth to 10' tall
Michael Dodge	'Michael Dodge' - heavy production of bright yellow fruit; grows 8 - 12' tall; other traits similar to species
Oneida	'Oneida' - upright, spreading habit; prolific, persistent red fruits; leaves turn yellow to orange-red in fall; sporadic flowering after initial May flush; smoother stems and leaves than species; grows to 10' tall and wide
Cardinal Candy	'Cardinal Candy' (a.k.a. 'Henneke') - well-branched form; extremely hardy to -25° F; good flower production; profuse bright red fruit; grows to 6' tall
Xanthocarpum	'Xanthocarpum' - an older yellow-fruiting form; fruit is an amber yellow color; fruits are not produced as abundantly as with the new, better fruiting selections
