Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub > 8 feet

Height: 10' - 15' (equal spread)

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: upright spreading, large shrub

Ornamental Other: Semi-evergreen in a protected location. May bloom sporadically from spring to fall.

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 5b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: adaptable; sun or part shade; best in a protected site

Insect Disease

Fairly resistant to V. Leaf Beetle
