Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 10' - 15' (equal spread)

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: upright; multi-stem shrub

Ornamental Other: shelter from wind and winter sun; tolerates heavy shade

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade, Shade

Hardy To Zone: 5a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Cultivar Name	Notes
Cree	'Cree' - smaller leaves than the species (to 6" long); slightly more cold hardy; profuse flowers
Green Trump	'Green Trump' - compact form; rounder more lustrous dark green evergreen foliage; white flowers; deer browse resistant; grows to 8' tall x 6' wide
Roseum	'Roseum' - pink buds open to yellowish-white flowers; otherwise similar to species
Variegatum	'Variegatum' - irregularly variegated with splashes of creamy white on some of the leaves; variegation is inconsistent, plant frequently reverts to green growth
