#### **C**rnamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet
Height: 8' - 10' (less spread)
Leaves: Deciduous
Shape: oval - rounded shrub
Ornamental Other: adaptable; best in full sun

#### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Full sun, Part shade Hardy To Zone: 5b Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

#### Insect Disease

Fairly susceptible to V. Leaf Beetle, especially in the shade

## Cultivars for Viburnum x burkwoodii

Cultivar Name	Notes
Anne Russell	'Anne Russell' - dense mounding form; profuse pink buds open to fragrant white flowers; glossy dark green leaves; crimson-purple fall color; hardy to zone 4, may be semi-evergreen in warmer climates; grows to 6' high x 8' wide
Chenaultii	'Chenaultii' - flowers profusely one week later than the normal hybrid; bronze fall foliage
Mohawk	'Mohawk' - compact form; dark red floral buds open late to white flowers; superior fall color of orange-red hues or burgundy; grows to 6' tall and wide
Compact Beauty	'Compact Beauty' - compact form with shorter internodes; slower growing; Based upon the rapid growth rate and ultimate size of V. x burkwoodii'; grows to 6' 10 years, can reach at least 8' tall and wide at maturity
Fulbrook	'Fulbrook' - similar to 'Anne Russell'; matte foliage; pink buds open to white fragrant flowers; grows to 8' tall x 10' wide
Park Farm Hybrid	'Park Farm Hybrid' - evergreen to semi-evergreen foliage in warmer areas; very glossy and longer tinner leaves than other hybrids; deep pink buds open to longer-lasting, larger flowers than other hybrids; grows 8 - 10' high and wide
